ON tan varios los tesoros, tan varios los despojos de letras i virtudes, que al divino Isidoro sobre apuesta hermoſeah, que por excelencia ſe alçò con la variedad [ſin la qual no ai hermoſura] por ſer juſto que eſta reſiera tantas, i tan varias de tal varon; de ella pues valiendome en eſta, como en otras feſtivities, en que varias oratorias a lo Latino yeſtidas tocò de retorica mi pluma, me expuſe a explayarme por la plumoſa variedad, o varias plumas de aquellos, que por morir Ciſnes renacieron Fenix en la memoria de los humanos, para panegirizar en la corta carrera de trabajo no corto, el oro de la ſabiduria de Isidoro, i la piedra precioſa de ſu ſantiſſima virtud.

Hallaràs [o prudente lector] en eſte Panegirico obſervadas con toda obediencia las leyes preceptivas de Centon, ſin mudar numero de algun nombre, o verbo, ſin traſtrocar, entrelacar, ni interponer parte de oracion alguna, ſin quitar ni añadir alguna interjeccion, conjuncion, o particula. Hallaràs verſos [aunque pocos] citados ſolamente con el nombre del Autor; que ſi por no ſer ſacados de la fuente pierden algo de lo ſuave, no de la autoridad, que por eſſo digo *teſte Textore*, de quien ſon citados en ſus epitetos, i fue la cauſa la ambicion de querer dilatarme en mas variedad, y no ſer poſſible tener todos los textos. No hallaràs Centon de una parte de oracion, porque eſta es en comun de todos, i en particular de ninguno, de dos es el menor, y el mayor de dos verſos ſeguidos cortados, i eſto no mas de dos vezes, permitido ſerà, pues no ſe prohibe al que es nada eſcrupuloſo, que los componga de tres. *Valens.*
