ON tan varios los tesoros, tan varios los despojos de letras i virtudes, que al divino Isidoro sobre apuesta hermoso ha, que por excelencia se alçó con la variedad [sin la qual no ai hermosura] por ser justo que esta refiera tantas, i tan varias de tal varón; de ella pues va-liendome en esta, como en otras festividades, en que varias oratorias a lo Latino vestidas tocó de retórica mi pluma, me expuse a explayarme por la plomosa variedad, o varias plumas de aquellos, que por morir Cisnes renacieron Fenix en la memoria de los humanos, para panegirizar en la corta carrera de trabajo no corto, el oro de la sabiduría de Isidoro, i la piedra preciosa de su Santissima virtud.

Hallarás [o prudente lector] en este Panegirico observadas con toda obediencia las leyes preceptivas de Centon, sin mudar numero de algun nombre, o verbo, sin trastrócar, entresacar, ni interponer parte de oracion alguna, sin quitar ni añadir alguna interjección, conjuncion, o particula. Hallarás versos [aunque pocos] citados solamente con el nombre del Autor; que si por no ser sacados de la fuente pierden algo de lo suave, no de la autoridad, que por ello digo *teste Textore*, de quién son citados en sus epítetos, i fue la causa la ambicion de querer dilatarme en mas variedad, y no ser posible tener todos los textos. No hallarás Centon de una parte de oracion, porque ésta es en comun de todos, i en particular de ninguno, de dos es el menor, y el mayor de dos versos seguidos cortados, i esto no mas de dos veces, permitido será, pues no se prohíbe al que es nada escrupuloso, que los componga de tres.
